

Private Vehicle Transportation Plan

If parents must drive, the District must do the following prior to the event:

- a. Acquire a copy of the primary insurance policy and their valid driver's license.
- b. Look at the vehicle for a general sense that the vehicle is safe for travel.
- c. No vehicle shall be utilized if the seating allows for ten or more people.
- d. Permission slips from parents allowing their children in a private, non-district vehicle. It shall be stated that the vehicle is driven by another parent.

If students must drive:

- a. Have a signed permission slip on file.
- b. Acquire a copy of proof of insurance.
- c. Look over the vehicle, making sure it is safe for travel.
- d. Only three passengers allowed.

If a student is a passenger:

- a. Have a signed permission slip on file giving permission for student to ride with another student for the duration of the season or activity.

Drivers under 18 years of age must follow intermediate driver license special rules:

1. For the first 6 months, you cannot drive with passengers under the age of 20 unless they are members of your immediate family.
2. For the next six months, you may not carry more than 3 passengers who are under 20 years old who are not members of your immediate family.
