Your willingness to learn & practice the skills of employability, initiative, and leadership is indicative of the successes you will achieve!

IT'S NOT TOO LATE TO JOIN NJROTC! It is FREE and does not obligate you to anything. Our Summer Orientation program is 17-19 August 2021. Tuesday-Wednesday will run from 8:30am to 12:00pm; Thursday will be 12:30 - 4:30 PM. Participants are asked to please bring a sack lunch Tue & Wed. Parents are invited to come view a small graduation ceremony and meet instructors on Thursday at 4:30 PM. Cadets who complete the Orientation (all 3 days) will receive their first ribbon and promotion to E2 at the close of the event (if they choose to enroll in the course)!

The purpose of this event is to provide new cadets with information about the benefits of NJROTC and how the program operates in the Marysville School District. 10th grade new students will assist with providing campus tours/virtual campuses tours and meet mentors from their school. We will introduce our standard classroom operating procedures, promotion requirements, field trips, and start issuing uniforms for those who indicate intent to enroll. We will also discuss the topics they can expect to cover during the course such as goal setting, time/project management, communication skills, online safety, GPA management, college prep, CPR and banking. Our two newest classes are Drones & Intro to Cyber Security. The multiple available credits & dual crediting will also be explained. 10th grade students entering the program will also have opportunities to lead and mentor 9th grade students.

There is an informational zoom meeting scheduled to answer any questions you may have prior to signing up. This is open house style, instructors and cadets will be available to answer any questions you have on 13 April from 6-7pm. This COVID-SAFE Orientation is being organized and will be operated by the Cadet Staff. If you enroll, please plan on attending all 3 days, dress school appropriate, and be ready to participate in team building activities. Members from our Cyber Patriots (code), Drones, Drill, Academic, Color Guards, Air Rifle, Orienteering, and PT team leaders will also be here to share. If transportation is a concern, let us know so Boosters may assist.

BENEFITS OF NJROTC

- **DISTRICT PROGRAM.** Students from any high school in the district may participate. Transportation is available in most cases. Zero period does not have transportation to locations & 7th period does not have transportation home.
- **MULTIPLE & EQUIVALENT REQUIRED CREDITS AVAILABLE.** You can earn PE, Health, CTE, Fine Art, General Elective, & Science. If you stay in the program for 2-years, you earn CWP or Senior Civics equivalency. If you stay 4-yr you earn both CWP & Senior Civics credits. This frees up your schedule to take other classes you may want or have a shorter schedule (less classes) your Senior year.
 - **MULTIPLE CTE COURSES/8 AVAILABLE CLASSES A DAY.** Intro to Naval Science, Maritime History & Nautical Sciences, Navy Knowledge & Skills, Career Exploration & Employability, Leadership, Drill, or Drone STEM, and Intro to Cyber Security. Taking advantage of Zero and/or 7th period(s) allows cadets to earn more credits early on.
- **FOCUS ON EMPLOYABILITY FOR ANY FIELD.** Courses and the classrooms are structured as a workplace. Lessons and activities are presented to our employees by our senior employees and instructors. All employees clock in everyday on time, follow standard operating procedures/schedules, communicate appropriately and respectfully(verbally, in writing, & online), wear our brand representation (Navy uniform) on designated days, learn to pay taxes, and take advantage of leadership/teamwork opportunities.
- **COLLEGE PREP.** Lesson on test taking and test prep. ASVAB/ACT/SAT/PSAT STUDY BOOKS and (free to cadets)online websites.
- **MILITARY CAREER PATHS.** 2 or more years, leads to enlistment at advanced pay grades up to E3. If military officer is the chosen path, we assist with qualification/application for appointments to any of the academies, ROTC, and Prep programs.
 - **HANDS ON PRACTICAL APPLICATION OF LEADERSHIP & TEAMWORK.** Classes use military rank structure for cadets to daily practice class & organization leadership. Each class has 5 specific leadership positions, cadets will have daily opportunities to lead and follow. The program has 12 leadership roles to provide oversight, event planning/project management, personnel development, and budget maintenance. There are also 8 different extracurricular competitive teams that cadets can choose to participate on. Each team is a varsity letter level opportunity. The teams are: Cyber Patriots, Orienteering, Air Rifle, Academic, Physical Strength, Color Guards, Armed and Unarmed Drill. There are also some individual drill opportunities.
- **FIELD TRIPS & EVENTS.** The cadets plan, coordinate, lead and manage specific events every year; Annual Military Inspection, Basic Leadership Training, Military Ball, Awards Night, & Summer Orientation. We regularly visit Naval Air Station Whidbey, Submarine Base Bangor(**on submarine**), Pacific Marine Research Puget Sound day cruise, Overnight at Museum of Flight including Mission to Mars/Moon, & Boeing.
