

7250 SCHOOL AND FACILITY NAMES

School buildings and separate school facilities, both on school grounds and within school buildings, shall be named only by formal action of the Board of Education. In naming schools and facilities, the Board shall strive to honor the traditions and high ideals of this district and the community it serves.

A school building or school facility may be named to memorialize the outstanding service of former district employees, citizens who lived within the school district, or former students of the school district.

The Board welcomes the suggestions of members of the community in the naming of school buildings and facilities and may appoint a committee of interested persons to conduct appropriate studies and make recommendations for Board consideration.

When naming a facility, the following criteria shall be considered:

- 1) The proposed name shall be appropriate
- 2) The name will stand the test of time
- 3) There shall be evidence of the nominee's distinguished service or other honors

The school board will make the final decision to name or rename a building or facility.
