

Lawrence Foundation Scholarship

The Lawrence Foundation for Buffalo Preservation and Agricultural Heritage has announced the establishment of a scholarship to provide financial aid to a graduating senior of Clifton-Clyde High School. The foundation has as one of its major objectives the preservation and promotion of agriculture and its heritage.

The scholarship shall be awarded to a senior who requires assistance in order to further his/her education. The \$500 scholarship may be used in any two- or four-year college, vocational-technical program, or trade school that leads to a career in agriculture. Additionally, the scholarship may be renewed for the same amount for a second year.

The scholarship amount will be paid to the school upon proof of enrollment for the second semester after completion of one successful semester. That means a 2.0 overall grade point average, with a 3.0 grade point average in major.

The criteria for the selection of the recipient shall be based upon the promise of usefulness in future years, financial need, leadership, scholastic ability, and scores on ACT tests. The choice shall be made by a committee of three, consisting of a teacher, a director of the foundation, and a school counselor. Vacancies on the committee will be filled by the foundation.
