TIC-TAC-TOE

Your row can be horizontal, vertical, or diagonal. Complete each assignment in your summer reading journal.

Create 2 Illustrations of important scenes from the novel. Write a paragraph describing each scene	Create a venn diagram or double bubble showing the similarities and differences between 2 characters from the novel. Provide at least 5 characteristics listed in each section.	Create a Plot Mountain Introduce the gist, rising action (problem), climax, falling action, and resolution.
Imagine the book you are reading is going to become a movie. Create the movie poster for this book.	Identify sensory language from a page or chapter. What did you see, hear, smell, taste, touch, feel? Provide examples from the text and include an illustration.	Chapter Summary Pause at the end of each chapter and write a summary including a main event from the chapter.
Create a scrapbook page for a character in your novel. You can use objects, photographs, illustrations, pictures from magazines, etc.	Create a glossary in your journal with a minimum of 10 unknown words.
