<b>Physical Education:</b>	Health and Physical Education is required for all freshmen.	1 Credit
<b>Fine Arts:</b>	Art, Band, Music Appreciation, or Vocal	1 Credit

<b>Social Science:</b>	Required: World History/World Geography (1 Credit), American History (1 Credit), Government (1/2 Credit), Economics (1/2 Credit).	3 Credits
<b>Foreign Language:</b>	Must be two credits of the same language (ie, Spanish I and Spanish II)	2 Credits
<b>Physical Education:</b>	Health and Physical Education is required for all freshmen.	1 Credit
<b>Fine Arts:</b>	Art, Band, Music Appreciation, or Vocal	1 Credit

Qualification for admissions into five out of six regents institution (See Kansas University requirements below) requires students to A) Complete the Pre-College or Kansas Scholars Curriculum with a minimum GPA of 2.0 **AND** B) Act score of 21 or higher **OR** Graduate in the top 1/3 of their class **AND** C) Achieve a 2.0 GPA or higher on any college credit taken in high school.

Qualification for admissions into Kansas University requires students to A) Complete the Pre-College or Kansas Scholars Curriculum with a minimum GPA of 2.0 **AND** B) 3.0 overall GPA and Act score of 24 or higher **OR** 3.25 GPA and ACT score of 21 or higher **AND** C) Achieve a 2.0 GPA or higher on any college credit taken in high school.

Kansas Regents institutions include: Emporia State University, Fort Hays State University, Kansas State University, Pittsburg State University, the University of Kasas, and Wichita State University.
