## **PCs for People – Eligibility Requirements**

To receive technology and services from PCs for People, a potential recipient must have a photo ID and be below the 200% poverty level or currently enrolled in an income-based government assistance program.

### **Accepted Eligibility Documents-**

All proof of eligibility must be dated within 6 months (unless it is an annual document, like a tax return), and include the recipient's name printed on the proof (exception for school schedules)

#### ***Acceptable documentation consists of the following:***

- Adult & Child Mental Health Case Manager
  - MUST be on official letterhead
- Employment Services
- Extended Foster Care
  - MUST be on official letterhead
- Supplement Nutrition Assistance Program (must be a screenshot of active account)
  - Online app
  - Or link ebt - <https://ebt-link.illinois.gov/ilebtclient/login>
- Financial Assistance, such as GA, TANF, etc. (a dated letter showing current eligibility is required)
- Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
- Medicaid or Medical Assistance (bring Document that say “MA” or “Medical Assistance” on it) all medical documents must show an effective date within the calendar year.
  - For example: Recipient A applied for a computer on January 5, 2021, Medicaid letter should say “Beginning December 1, 2020”.
- The National School Lunch Program’s Free and Reduced-Lunch Application
  - Must be signed and dated by a school official
- Section 8, Federal Public Housing Assistance, or Group Residential Housing (GRH)
  - Copy of your Lease with current lease timeline
- Social Security Disability (SSD)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Statement of benefits from Social Security, General Assistance, Veterans Administration, Retirement/Pension or Unemployment Benefits
  - If the date on your benefit card is not within the current calendar year, please bring a copy of your most recent payment stub.
- Pell Grant
- Persons affected by school closures due to COVID-19 –
  - Screenshot or letter of school closure (only eligible for a computer)
  - Screenshot or copy of your student’s official school schedule.
  - Screenshot of your student’s portal schedule
