USDA Food Service Program – Non Discrimination

The Mascenic School District – School Board policy AC complies with all federal non-discrimination policies.

In accordance with Federal Civil Rights Law and US Department of Agriculture (USDA) civil rights regulations and policies, the USDA, its agencies, offices and employees and institutions participating in or administering USDA programs are prohibited from discriminating based on race, color, national origin, sex, disability, age or reprisal or retaliation for any prior civil rights activity in any program or activity conducted or funded by USDA.
