

## **Attendance Waiver Update**

Dear Parents & Guardians,

If your child currently attends school on an attendance waiver AND/OR you would like to apply for an attendance waiver for the 23-24 school year, PCPS would like to share updated information regarding attendance waivers. If your child attends their home/zoned school, no further action is needed.

Starting with the 2023-2024 school year, all attendance waivers will be completed through the Parent Portal in PowerSchool.

- Log in to the Parent Portal,
- Click Forms on the left-hand side,
- Click Application for Attendance Waiver
  - Please read the application in its entirety. By submitting the form, you are agreeing that you have read the application.
  - Please answer all questions, including reasoning for the waiver request, before submitting.

Please note, you will not receive an automatic reply regarding your child's waiver status. Parents and Guardians will receive an email notification about waiver status by August 1, 2023.

## Prior to completing the Attendance Waiver form, please read the following FAQs:

- I. When space is available and enrollment projections allow, students may be granted permission to attend schools in another attendance zone under one of the following conditions:
  - A. students of PCPS employees,
  - B. families whose child care resides in another attendance zone, or
  - C. for extenuating circumstances.
- II. If approved, parents/guardians will be responsible for their student's transportation to and from the requested school.
- III. Attendance Waiver forms must be completed per child on an annual basis.
- IV. After waivers have been approved, any parent/guardian who wishes for their student to return to their home school **must notify the current principal in writing**.
- V. Among other reasons, waivers may be denied or revoked for:
  - A. unacceptable academic performance;
  - B. unacceptable behavior at either school; and/or
  - C. unacceptable attendance (including late arrivals and early dismissals) at either school.
