Carryover Funds

ESSER III may be used to address student learning gaps, mental health needs, summer school, extended day programs, professional development, safety needs and sanitation requirements, etc.

FY 2024 uses - mental health/behavior curriculum; equipment & supplies for safety, communication & sanitation; summer school/academy, after school, & Saturday tutorial staff and materials; supplemental learning supplies; professional development; CTE supplements and equipment; digital resources, such as, but not limited to survey monkey, class link, apptegy.

Title I

Every Student Succeeds Act 2015 (ESSA) - provide supplemental funding to schools serving high concentrations of students from low-income homes. These funds are specifically for the elementary and intermediate schools.
