





# Information Provided by District/Program

We work hard to keep our students with disabilities in the general education program as much as possible. Unfortunately, we were slightly short of the 75% or more state target for general education placement at 73.48%. Our four year graduation rate for our special education students is 11% below the state target at 75%. Again, our staff do everything possible by providing pathways to graduation for our students with disabilities.




# FOUR-YEAR COHORT GRADUATION RATE

Students with IEPs earning a regular or modified diploma within four years.




# FIVE-YEAR COHORT GRADUATION RATE






Students with an IEP who enrolled in higher education or were competitively employed within one year of leaving high school.

A written statement for a child with a disability that is developed, reviewed, and revised by an IEP Team.

# **Special Education (SE)**

Special education means specially designed instruction, at no cost to the parents, to meet the unique needs of a child with a disability.
