Principal's Report: Dr. Jay Dostal:

Mr. Collier reported that they are trying to encourage students to finish the year strong. Advisory teachers are performing grade checks and helping students set goals. There is a watch list for students who are struggling and who are close to not passing. Staff is implementing a reward and motivation system for students not struggling. Raising Cane's has donated gift cards, hoping to get more incentives and asking PTSO for any help they can provide.

Dostal gave a shout out to Mr. Collier for leading the team for restorative practices—focused on repairing relations rather than suspending students, also helping kids overcome anxiety when coming back to school. Dostal emphasized that small tokens of appreciation go a long way.

Funds come in and out of our account for them and you will see these reflected on the report, but they are not funds for PTSO budget. We have \$683 left to allocate/spend, Liz Rusher moved to give Mr. Collier \$280 for student rewards and \$400 to Project Graduation. Christy Plummer seconded and the motion passed. We collected \$234 from spirit nights not reflected in today's report. We will split that with Dawg Crew per our agreement to work together.
