**SOCIAL STUDIES:**

Oakridge School District Administration recommends approval of the following Social Studies Textbooks for Adoption and implementation in our K-12 classrooms.

Instructional materials adopted are scheduled to be implemented beginning in the 2022-2023 school year.

Textbooks serve as resources currently funded by the Instructional Material Allotment within our general fund budget for the 2022-2023 school year.

The process for adoption was led in the Spring of 2022 by Director Peter Iten. Staff members were engaged in the process of review and selection of the materials. Materials were available for staff and community to review, both virtually and in person. In addition to the adopted materials, supplemental materials will be purchased as needs are determined by teachers. These might include updated maps and other items related to teaching Social Studies.
