A positive COVID-19 case means a student or staff member has tested positive for COVID-19, is currently isolated, and is not at school. Reasons for quarantine include: travel, close contact with a positive case (within 6 ft. for 15 minutes), waiting on COVID-19 test results, etc. Quarantine does not include positive cases. Positive cases are reflected in the # of confirmed first-hand positive case of COVID-19 results.
