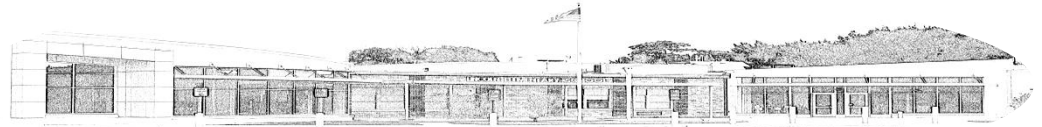

Laptop Collection Process
