**RESOLUTION #TY 2019, REGARDING THE ESTIMATED AMOUNTS
NECESSARY TO BE LEVIED**

WHEREAS, The Truth in Taxation Act requires that all taxing districts in the State of Illinois determine the estimated amounts of taxes necessary to be levied for the year not less than twenty (20) days prior to the official adoption of the aggregate tax levy of the district; and

WHEREAS, if the estimated aggregate amount necessary to be levied, exclusive of the election costs, exceeds 105% of the aggregate amount of the property taxes extended or estimated to be extended upon the levy of the preceding year, public notice shall be given and a public hearing shall be held on the district's intent to adopt tax levy in an amount which is more than 105% of the extension or estimated extension for the preceding year; and


