The American Rescue Plan (ARP) Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER III) provides over \$12,000,000,000 to the State of Texas for public education, including over \$11,000,000,000 directly to Local Education Agencies. While the U.S. Department of Education (ED) has released approximately \$8,000,000,000 of that allocation to the state, in order to access the remaining funds, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) must submit and obtain ED approval of a state-level plan.

Seeking input from diverse stakeholders across the state is essential to developing plans for the use of approximately \$1,000,000,000 in ARP ESSER III state-level discretionary funds that are responsive to the needs of students, families, and educators.
