

## UNOFFICIAL MINUTES OF SPECIAL SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BELLE FOURCHE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 9-1 MET IN SPECIAL SESSION ON MONDAY, MAY 17, 2021, AT THE BELLE FOURCHE ADMINISTRATION OFFICE with president Clem presiding and members Gilbert, Helmer, Justice, Knapp, Reder and Tyndall present.
