- Executive Order 117 All schools must be closed for in-school instruction on election day, November 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- <u>S-993/A-631</u> (P.L.2020, c.66) Provides for binding arbitration for non-certificated staff on disciplinary actions, with a greatly expanded definition of what is considered a "disciplinary action". The bill has already been signed by the Governor
- Senate Bill 2843 This bill is opposed by the NJSBA, as it places greater restrictions on school districts, regarding the hiring and firing of athletic coaches.
