Things are running pretty smoothly right now at RJSHS

**P/T conferences:** are running a little differently this spring. My goal is to have 95% direct parent contact.

1. Teachers will select their students
2. Teachers will gather the following information from other teachers
  1. Grades - Quick look up
  2. Attendance report - Same quick look up
  3. Tardy report - Quick look up
  4. Information specific to student from other teachers.
3. Teachers will call parents and talk with them to give review of classes
  1. Log all calls with date, time, and who you talked to
  2. Missed calls - leave messages (at least 3 with no return calls).
  3. If parents wish to talk to a specific teacher, please let them know that you will give the teacher their name and they will call them back
4. Teachers will build a Manilla folder for all students on their list
  1. Will include all of the information that was gathered for the phone call
  2. We will send them home 7th hour on Monday, February 22nd.
5. All initial parent conference phone calls will be completed to parents by Tuesday, February 23, 2021.
6. Thursday, February 25, 2021 from 4:00 - 8:00, teachers will be in the school to return all follow up phone calls with parents that requested individual calls. Once calls are completed, this time will be used for classroom work, lesson preparation, grading, updating PowerSchool, etc.
