Learning Program Options 2021-2022

Beginning August 11, 2021, all Reef-Sunset Unified School District students will return to full-time, in-person, on campus learning.

RSUSD will introduce a virtual learning option in the RSUSD Virtual Learning Program. This program was created as an alternate education environment suited for TK-12 students and families who found success in remote learning.

Where & When	At school 5 days per week at school of residence. Students will be physically in school following necessary health and safety precautions.	At home 5 days per week Online instruction Students will engage in a balance of live interaction (synchronous) and independent work (asynchronous) throughout the day. Students must be enrolled in an RSUSD school in order to participate.			
		Students will be assigned to a District Virtual Learning teacher.			
Program Option Transition	If the in-person program option was selected, but the parent wishes to transfer to a Virtual Learning Program option, you may apply during the school year. Admittance will be based on Virtual Learning Program space availability.	Year long commitment. If you decide to withdraw your student from the program, the student must return to in-person instruction at their school of residence, space permitting.
