If your child is on a 504 plan, the site administrator will contact you to schedule a meeting to discuss appropriate accommodations.</p> <p>Transportation Parents are responsible for transporting the student to and from services.</p>
Social Emotional Supports	Social-emotional supports are available to all students in all programs.	
Program Option Transition	If the in-person program option was selected, but the parent wishes to transfer to a Virtual Learning Program option, you may apply during the school year. Admittance will be based on Virtual Learning Program space availability.	Year long commitment. If you decide to withdraw your student from the program, the student must return to in-person instruction at their school of residence, space permitting.
Local and State Assessments	Students will participate in regularly scheduled state and local assessments.	Students in Grades 3-12 are required to test in-person for state testing. English learners will be required to test in-person for ELPAC. Some local assessments may require students to test in-person.
Athletics & Activities	Students may participate in after school sports and other extracurricular activities offered at their school of residence, if they maintain eligibility.	
Grading	District adopted grading policies will apply.
