

Grads Find Year Exciting, Challenging


It is always great to look ahead at being a senior and having this be the last year of high school, but it is hard to think that this is my last football game, the last time I will lead a cheer as a

vides for lifelong memories.



This year's staff saw a few changes as Mr. Scott Grochow took over the junior high and Mr. Mark Woodbury took the reigns for the C-Squad.


The varsity team had a tremendously successful record, even getting a mention


The B-Squad, coached by Mr. John Abrahamson, placed third in the McLean County B-Squad Tourney at Turtle Lake.




