### Kindergarten Enrollment

We will begin Kindergarten enrollment on:

**Monday, February 26<sup>th</sup>**

You may pick up an enrollment packet in the office. Please remember that we must have a copy of your child's birth certificate, \*proof of residence, social security card and immunization record in order to enroll him/her in school.

The new law requires that children must be 5 on or before September 1, 2018 to enroll in Kindergarten. If your child will turn 5 between Sep 2<sup>nd</sup> and Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup>, your child will be in a Transitional Kindergarten classroom.

**\*PG&E, water bill or mortgage/rental agreement are required as proof of residence.**
