In Joshua 1:7-8, God promised Joshua that he would have success as long as they followed God's Word. As a family, read Joshua 6:1-19; 7:1-5 and 7:10-13 Family Time and discuss the following questions:

- What were God's instructions for His people after they defeated Jericho?
- Why did Joshua and Israel lose their first battle against Ai?
- What does this say about God's commitment to His promises?
- What does it say about our obedience and disobedience?
- Does our personal obedience or disobedience have an effect on others? How and why?

QUESTIONS FOR YOUR GROWTH

- 1. In Joshua 1:1-6, God says to Joshua both that He is giving the land to the people (v. 2) and that Joshua will cause people to inherit the land (v. 6).
 - What was God's part in Israel obtaining the Promised Land, and what was Joshua's part?
 - Even though victory in taking the land was already guaranteed, what would have been the result if Joshua and the people would not have moved for fear of their enemies?
 - What other things has God promised that only come when His people step forward in
 - What decision or move has God called you to make, but you've hesitated because of fear? How is this passage encouraging to you?
- 2. In Joshua 1:7-8, God instructed to be "careful to do according to all that is written" in God's Word. Using these verses and the cross references in point 2 above for help...
 - What does it mean to be "careful" in following God's Word? What does it look like to not be careful?

- Why is it important to do according to "all" that is written? If you were honest, which instructions in God's Word would you rather not follow and why?
- How does following God's Word help you grow in further following God's Word?
- 3. Sometimes we expect God to bring us success according to how we define success.
 - What was the "success" that was promised to Joshua if he would obey?
 - How do we as Christians in our culture often define success?
 - Is that what God promises us if we obey?
 - How can even struggles and hardships contribute toward God's bring of success to us (You might consider Romans 8:28-29 in your answer)?
- **4.** One of the main themes in the book of Joshua is the Presence of God going with the people of Israel into the Promised Land. Read Deuteronomy 31:1-8 and skim the subtitles in Josh. chs. 8-12.
 - Why was God's Presence so important in the people of Israel taking the Promised Land? What did it provide?
 - What situations in your life right now are difficult, and where you need God to go before you, to be with you, and to watch your back?
 - Spend some time in the Bible (you can use the cross references in point 3 above) and in prayer this week asking God to lead you, to be with you, and to be your defense. Then...move when He tells you to, knowing He's with you.
