## 1. Regular Governing Board Meeting Agenda

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance

Miss Juarez called the board meeting to order at 5:31 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Ms. Zendejas.

#### 2.1.4. Robotics Tournament ELC and SMS

Dr. Noel discussed the following items:

- Board members training with the attorneys: Board members would like the board training to be on Tuesday, January 24 at 5:30 pm.
- Proposition 206 on minimum wage passed. Mrs. Porchas mentioned that by law any employees under \$10.00 will be required to pay them \$10.00 effective January 1st. The salary schedule will change as of January 1st and any new staff will be hired at that wage. We do not need to change anyone else because that would be considered a gift of public funds. The budget will reflect this change over a period of three years. In 2018 it will be \$10.50. In 2019 it will be \$11.00 and in 2020 it will be \$12.00. This change will affect only six of our employees.
- Dr. Noel asked the board member to begin discussions about Valle del Encanto Learning Center
  now that it is a K-5 school; whether the school will use ELC or VDELC. Board members agreed
  to continue using ELC, Encanto Learning Center.
- Dr. Noel mentioned SMS and ELC attended the First LEGO League Robotics competition on Saturday, December 3rd at AWC. Mr. Munoz reported this is the first year ELC 5th grade students attend a state tournament. Thirty-six local teams competed, including ELC's Bionic Stars team. Ten teams compete at state level. There are three main Core Awards given to teams, the Project Award, Core Values Award, and the Robot Design Award. ELC received the Core Values Award. This award celebrates a team that is empowered by their FLL experience and displays extraordinary enthusiasm and spirit.

5.2. Approval of the Resolution of the Governing Board of Somerton School District #11 of Yuma County, Arizona, authorizing the execution and delivery of a taxable equipment lease-purchase agreement to finance the lease and ultimate acquisition of curriculum software for any district school that qualifies as a qualified zone academy as directed by this Board and to pay project costs and costs of bond counsel and costs of issuance; authorizing the appointment of an escrow agent; and authorizing the president, superintendent and assistant superintendent to take all actions and do all things necessary to complete the transaction or transactions contemplated herein. (Resolution)

Dr. Noel explained that the Resolution Agreement QZAB terms of interest rate to the district is 0%. Payment terms of 5 years as follow: 2018: \$135,000 for the first two years and \$800,000 for the last two years.
