## Hello Central School District Families,

As we approach the start of the school year and students' first day of school on August 10th, we want to share more information regarding our Distance Learning Program. This program consists of students in grade 1 - 8 logging in and interacting with their teachers for approximately four hours throughout the instructional day (see chart below for times for each grade level.) Transitional kindergarten and kindergarten students will be divided into classes and receive instruction with the teacher for 2 hours a day in their assigned AM or PM session (see TK-K instructional day below). Students will also be working independently on assignments as directed by the teacher during the instructional day. Students will receive instruction in Language Arts, Social Studies, Math, Science, and PE, with elementary students receiving music instruction as well. Middle school students will follow their assigned student schedule with a class period for study hall/silent reading in lieu of an elective class. Band and some intervention classes may still be offered. Special education students will receive a distance learning plan from their case carrier the week of August 10th.

Elementary students will be given a regularly scheduled recess break and all students district-wide will be given a scheduled lunch break from 11:50-12:30, with meals being distributed at school sites to eligible and interested families on Mondays and Wednesdays from 11:00-12:30. Students will be held accountable for attending class every day and completing all class assignments. Progress reports and regular report cards will be based on completion of work and student mastery. Following the school calendar students will attend class(es) Monday through Friday, with Wednesdays designated "early release" for elementary schools and Fridays being designated "late start" for middle schools (see below). If your child does not have access to a device in order to participate in online learning, please call the district office at (909)484-5301. If leaving a message, please leave your child's first and last name, school, grade level and student identification number if you know it and our technology department will get back to you. Make sure to complete your student's data confirmation using the Aeries parent portal to confirm your child's class assignment. Additional information regarding the 2020-21 school year will be sent to you from your school principal next week. Make sure you've downloaded the Central School District 91730 app to ensure receiving regular updates.

This week school offices are open to the public from 8:00 am – noon. Beginning Monday, August  $3^{\rm rd}$ , all offices are open from 8:00 -4:00. Please note that on Friday August  $7^{\rm th}$  all offices will not open until 11:00 am due to a district-wide virtual meeting.
