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Police, fire, Border Patrol, Sheriff, and Cocopah vehicles were parked over at Somerton Middle School and some of the students were able to go and see the equipment and visit with the personnel.

• Dr. Reed, Mrs. Porchas, and Mr. Cabrera met with APS to do a preliminary energy audit and discuss the results. The Somerton School Districtwould definitely be saving money.

#### 2.2.1. President and other Board member comments

Miss Juarez commented that she was elected as a new board member to go to Washington D.C. on November 17-21, 2010.

#### 2.3. Administrators/Directors Report

2.3.1. Bob. Cassidy, Director of Technology and Dominic McIntire--E-Rate implementation progress report outlining the work being done on the network, phone system and School Messenger.

Mr. Cassidy reported the process of the School Messenger Notification System. That this program will allow the district to contact groups of parents by phone, e-mail and/or text messaging. Also, he mentioned that he is in the middle of a three million dollar E-Rate implementation to upgrade data, voice and video networking districtwide.

2.3.2. Elizabeth Santos, Coordinator of Health Service--Communicable diseases and 45 day screenings. Ms. Santos discussed the following:

Each school site completed their 45 day screenings

Ms. Santos mentioned on how to deal with students who have a communicable disease in regard to how long they may need to be excluded from school, and under which conditions they will be allowed to return to school. Also, said that it is likely that the district will start to see a number of communicable disease that might not have been as prevalent in the past, but because we have students coming in from other parts of the country and from Mexico, we need to be prepared to deal with these students, should this become an issue. Hepatitis A, Salmonella outbreaks, Cholera, Typhoid fever, and Active TB may be just a few of the disease that students may contract in the future. She will work closely with the Public Health Dept. when she is dealing with students who have Communicable disease that require exclusion from school to prevent the spread of these disease.

Flu Clinic visited our school on October 21 we had a good response from our staff.

Sunset Community Health Clinic will be working with district to providing Dental Care to the district students who are under insured or who have no insurance. Also, in the future may be able to provide on-site clinics in our district, so we want to support their effort in obtaining funding.

Also, she is concerned that all students who are in 6th grade have their Meningitis Vaccine and Tdap booster as required by law, by Nov. 15th, so that first of all that they don't get any of these disease and that the district is in compliance with the law.

## 2.3.9. Jorge Cano, Director of Food Service

Food Service Employees attended the Child Abuse Training on 9-22-10 at ELC Food Service provided dinner for ASBA Yuma County Workshop on 10-14-10 at SMS

Mr. Cano mentioned that his staff attended the Child Abuse Training and dinner was provided for ASBA Yuma County Workshop.

Mrs. Camacho thanked Mr. Cano for the dinner during ASBA Yuma County Workshop.

#### 2.3.10. Maria Villarreal, Transportation--New bus routes.

Mrs. Villarreal commented the new bus routes and how the bus drivers are working very hard. She mentioned that one of the buses was in an accident, the students were not hurt.

Miss Juarez asked about the bus driver.

Mrs. Villarreal mentioned that bus driver is doing fine. Also, she mentioned that she has received several concern calls regarding not having bus aide when they are transporting the students from and to school.
