3.3.2. Ms. Mezei, Director of Federal Programs

Title 1, Title 111 After school programs have ended Migrant after-school program to continue at SMS Balancing of budgets to determine amounts for:

Ms. Mezei discussed that after school tutorial programs have ended, funded by T-1 and T-111. Migrant programs are continuing at SMS only, for after school tutorials.

Summer School budgets are finalized, dates are June 6-17 for all schools, except TDS May 31-June 3.

ARRA Application was submitted to cover full cost of summer school, waiting on notification.

3.3.3. Mrs. Seh, Director of Professional Development

AIMS Testing completed, Math Curriculum Mapping, and STEM Training this summer funded by Mentor Grant

Aims tests were picked up on May 3 and May 10. All Aims were accounted for and numbers were clean. Math Curriculum mapping has begun with Nora Ramirez as our facilitator. The maps are going to be very scaffolded giving us a plan for implementation. Science Technology, engineering and Math training is happening in July and this was funded by the Mentor Grant.

3.3.4. Mrs. Volpe, Director of ELL/Highly Qualified

AZELLA testing update and the lawsuit decision about ELL Home Language Surveys.

Mrs. Volpe reported that unlike the AIMS the AZELLA testing doesn't stop. She is always testing new students. She is currently doing reassessments on all continuing ELL students and have completed three of the five schools. She is almost finished with TDS and ELC. There was a lawsuit regarding the Home Language Survey that was changed in July 2009 from three questions to a one question survey, What is the primary language of the student? The finding of the court was that we had to go back to the three questions so as of April of 2011 all new students must have parents answer all three questions and we have to go back and locate all students who came after July 2009 and have their parents answer all three questions. I will have to track them and do two reports for the state as to how many of them will be tested and placed in ELL programs.

3.3.5. Mrs. Weissenberg, Migrant Coordinator

Migrant services provided during the school year. Progress on PBIS goals

Mrs. Weissenberg reported that 410 Migrant Eligible students at the beginning of the year. 339 received instructional support throught the year. Migrant funded Instructional Support offered: Day Interventions (Reading and Math), after-school tutorials (Reading & Math), Saturday School and Spring Break School, Summer school and SMS Ambassador's Club.

PBIS: District-wide initiative to decrease disciplinary incidents by implementing school-wide rules and procedures in each school.

Conducted 3 quarterly sweeps to check the following:

- School-wide rules poster in each classroom-93% of all classrooms.
- Teacher use rules classroom: 81%
