Not returning to Kellogg Marsh next year

If you are not returning to our school next year, please let the office know as soon as possible. We are busy planning for next year and it is helpful to be aware of our enrollment numbers when placing students into their new classrooms. Once you know which school your student will attend, please register as soon as possible at the new school. The new school will then request your student's records from us. If you are not returning, we wish you the best at your new school.



Weekly Health Screening

All students who attend in-person instruction need to complete a health screener. It is to be completed once a week on Sunday evening or early Monday morning before 7:30 am for your child to be allowed to proceed to class.



Student Illness Reminder

Please do not send your student to school if his or her illness requires, treatments such as: fever reducer, cough or sore throat medicine, anti-diarrheal or other treatments. If your child has any of these symptoms over the weekend, before school or on a school day, keep your child home and contact our office with the reason for his or her absence. We will let you know the date when your child may return based on the information you provide.

If your child has a COVID test, keep your child home until you get a copy of the results. Before your student can return to school, a copy of these results must be provided to our school nurse.

Thank you for helping us keep our students and staff safe and healthy.

Let's talk about Allergies

Allergies are quite common this time of the year and can closely resemble symptoms seen with Covid 19. If your child's allergy symptoms are not relieved by their usual allergy medication, please contact our attendance secretary before sending your child to school. Our district nurse will contact you to discuss symptoms and provide guidance on returning to school.

Reminder of Symptoms:

- Congestions or Runny Nose
- Cough
- Muscle or Body aches
- Diarrhea
- Sore Throat
- Shortness of Breath/Difficulty Breathing
- Headache
- Fatigue
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Loss of Taste or Smell

Kindergarten Registration

Registration is currently going on. If you have a child that will be turning 5 on or before August 31st its time to register him/her for kindergarten. You may go online at the Marysville School District Website and register there or you may stop by the KM Office and pick up a hardcopy to complete. You will need to supply a copy of the child's birth certificate and the most up-to-date immunizations your child has received. We are in the office from 8 am to 4 pm until the end of the school year.

Summer Meal Information

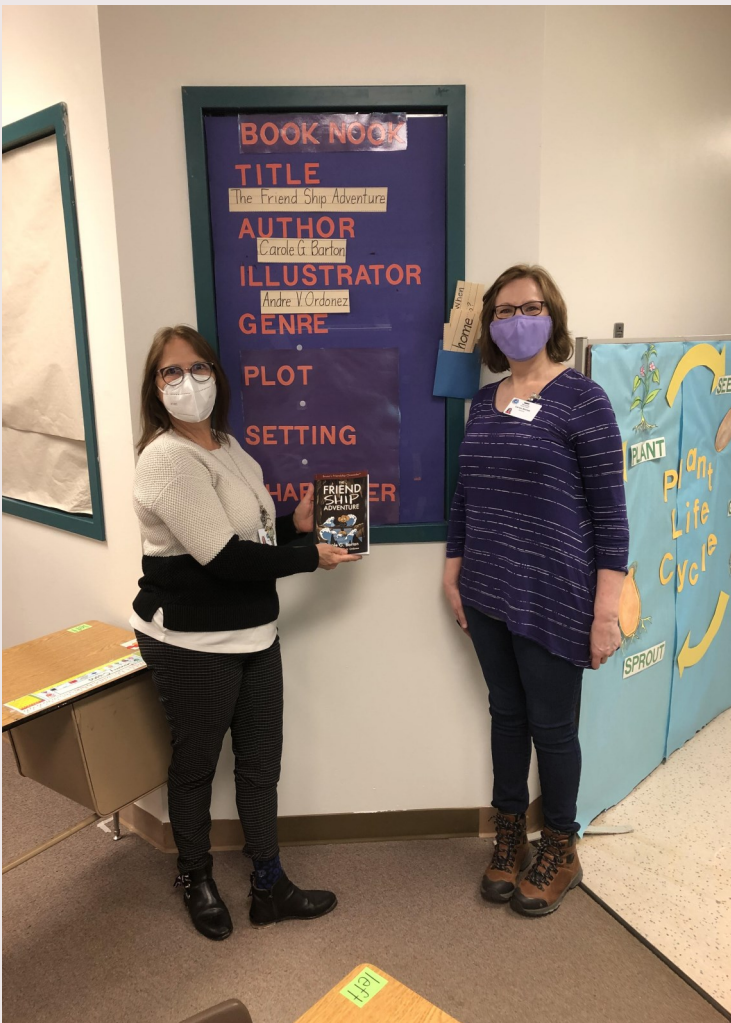
Summer Meals—Grab & Go
