PAYING FOR COLLEGE

Delta College costs less than half of what you'd pay at a public university, but you get the same quality education. Below are some options to help get you started in financing your dream. Check out delta.edu/costs-financial-aid

APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID (FAFSA)

More than 50% of Delta Students receive some form of financial aid. It's worth your time to apply.

APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Delta College Foundation supports many students through the generosity of donors providing funding. Typically, applications are available from December through February 1st. For more information on scholarship deadlines and application details visit delta.edu/scholarships.

PAYMENT PLAN (NELNET)

If a lump sum tuition bill doesn't fit into your budget, you can enroll in the NELNET tuition payment plan. We offer an online, short-term interest-free plan that will allow you to spread out your tuition and fees into smaller payments. The earlier you sign up, the more options you have available.

WORK-STUDY

Delta College offers eligible students employment opportunities through a federal program called work-study. It allows students to gain valuable work experience while earning money to pay for college. Students must complete the FAFSA to potentially be eligible.
