Buildings and Grounds Update - Mr. Jacobs

Mr. Jacobs began with thanking his department staff for preparing the buildings for the opening of school. He also introduced Rich Ganino, Assistant Director of Facilities. An update on the current projects – BHS Student Parking Lot fundraising project, Facilities Scheduler interactive mobile app, monthly meetings with Campus Construction and Wendel Architects for the 2020 Vision Project, and the introduction of the Navigate Prepared app for district safety (in collaboration with City of Batavia first responders), and the creation of a Drill Log with flip charts for all lockdowns, shelter in place, etc. was explained. Specifications are complete; will work with District Administration on the best way to implement this. Once cameras and locks are updated, a phone app can lock down our buildings instantly. This will enhance building safety across the District.

District Goals - Mr. Dailey

Mr. Dailey shared the newly developed District Goals for 2017-18. This year's focus is on taking care of Self – Others – Schools. The four goals are:

BCSD will create more opportunities to engage the Batavia Community.

WHEREAS, the District has developed a Policy for the safety of children who have contact with employees holding Emergency Conditional appointments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Board of Education of the City School District of Batavia hereby makes an Emergency Conditional appointment of <<u>EMPLOYEE</u>>, a <<u>TITLE</u>>, to the position of <<u>TITLE</u>> in the Batavia City School District. This Emergency Conditional appointment shall terminate when the District is notified that <<u>EMPLOYEE</u>> has been granted final

clearance for employment by the Commissioner of Education. Such Emergency Conditional appointment shall terminate immediately if the Commissioner of Education makes a determination to deny < <u>EMPLOYEE</u>> clearance for employment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if < <u>EMPLOYEE</u>> is granted final clearance for employment by the Commissioner of Education prior to a minimum 12-week period during his/her Emergency Conditional Appointment, or granted final clearance for employment at any time during his/her Conditional Employment, such Provisional appointment shall begin on the first day of continuous employment with the District pursuant to this appointment.

- Opening Exercises start on September 5th at 8:00 AM. All BOE are invited. Mr. Burk and I will greet the district. Jackson: Parents may visit from 9:00 AM -11:30 AM; John Kennedy: 12:30 PM 1:30 PM is 2nd grade parent and student visitation; 1:30 PM 2:30 PM 3rd and 4th grade parent and student visitation.
- On September 6, 2017, BMS Connect Day starts at 8:00 AM -1:00 PM for 5th grade;
 BHS Link Crew Day starts at 8:00 AM 2:45 PM for 9th graders and transfer students.
- First day of classes for all students is Thursday, September 7, 2017.
- We had 52 applicants for the High School Principal position. I narrowed the field to 12. We interviewed those 12 candidates on Monday via phone. We chose seven to bring to our Constituent Committee last Friday. We moved four candidates to the Leadership Committee Interviews on Wednesday, August 30th. Our goal is to have one or two candidates meet the faculty and staff on September 5th and 6th at 3:00 PM in the High School Library.
- The Genesee County Superintendents and GVEP Superintendent met with Senator Ranzenhoffer last Wednesday for about 2 hours. We discussed State Aid, APPR, Capital Projects, Smart Schools, and Mental Health Services. A Mental Health Department satellite office has been set up at Robert Morris 1 day/week. Senator Ranzenhoffer may look into this option for all school districts. It was very productive meeting.
- For the High School parking lot, 36 seniors have signed up to paint their spots. They have done a great job thus far!!
- As Dr. Corey reported this evening, we improved by 2% in both ELA and Math on NYS 3-8 Testing.
- I was on WBTA last Thursday morning discussing all the work we have done this summer at BCSD and sharing updates for our opening days.
