Comments &/or Suggestions from the Audience – Community member, Carl Eilertson voiced his concern on the health of students wearing masks mandated by the state.

Reports

- 1. Superintendent's Report
 - a) Resolution 2418 Emergency Waiver of High School Graduation Credits Mr. Fry reviewed with the Board the Emergency Waiver Resolution proposal the district will implement with guidelines that CPHS will follow.
 - b) Teacher Appreciation Mr. Fry read the Governor's Proclamation declaring the week of May 4th, 2021 to be teacher Appreciation Week. Mr. Fry thanked the teachers for their phenomenal work over the past year and stated his appreciation for their dedication to students.
 - c) Davis Portable Addition Project 2.0 Mr. Fry shared a schematic of the new portables layout that the district is planning to purchase to help with social distancing in the fall and the expected enrollment growth. The project will be paid in full using with ESSER stimulus funds. The project will be at the same cost as the portables purchased in 2020 as the company is under the same 2020 contract which will be a savings of about \$300,000.
- 2. Principals' Report
 - a) Mark Ferraro reported on the return of students and how well it is going with the return of 630 students. He spoke of the great work being done by staff and students and shared that Carnegie Picture Lab is back in schools with Davis Dragon, Rahema Durand being selected out 77 Walla Walla Valley students as the winner of the art contest with her submission.
 - b) Scott Kasenga shared the enrollment numbers at JSMS and thanked his amazing staff on their flexibility through all the changes and their continued high expectations of students. He spoke of the training of teachers and students in Sources of Strength to support teen leadership.
 - c) Robert Aguilar gave a shout out to his amazing office staff, Lori Bartlow and Edith Martinez, who run the office so smoothly and are so great with customer service. Mr. Aguilar reported on High School sports with both the baseball and softball teams being #1 seeds in the playoffs. The full return of students feels great. Students are making up lost ground and re-establishing a new routine. FBLA students finishing in the top 10 at state and lots of post High School planning with various partners and organizations on campus.
- 3. GEAR UP Brady Svilich Mr. Svilich presented to the Board the CPPS GEAR UP program and all the great things they are doing for the class of 2026 and 2027 in and out of classrooms to support them for success post High School in whatever career they pursue.

- 4. 21st Century Martin Fortney Mr. Fortney presented on the newly adopted the 21st Century 5-year grant program at CPPS. Mr. Fortney's team will work with students starting this summer and afterschool beginning in the fall with various STEM activities to keep them engaged and learning.
- 5. Comprehensive Sexual Health Education Curriculum Update Marissa Waddell updated the Board on the process and progress of the curriculum committee to meet the SB 5395 requirements and should have a recommendation to the Board for approval at the May Board meeting.
