1.2. Comments from the Audience

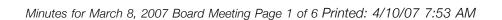

Mr. Heredia requested the Request of Visitors forms and informed the public that the forms were available. There were no comments at this time.

Valle Del Encanto made a huge improvement from 10% last year to 67% in student engagement. Orange Grove and Tierra Del Sol will be having the Data Sweep later in the week, but the expectations are the same with very high percentages.
