SEQRA RESOLUTION - NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR

ENERGY PERFORMANCE CONTRACT

DATED APRIL 21, 2022

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Tuxedo Union Free School District (the "Board of Education") proposes to enter into an energy performance contract to install various energy conservation measures and equipment at the District's school buildings and facilities, and other work in connection therewith, including incidental costs related thereto (the "Proposed Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education wishes to proceed with the Proposed Project and to take all actions necessary in connection therewith in order to comply with the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); and WHEREAS, the Board of Education, as the only involved agency, has reviewed the Proposed Project with respect to the Type II criteria set forth in the SEQRA Regulations at 6 NYCRR Part 617.5 and, based upon the recommendation from the District's consultant engineer, Energia, in connection with its review and examination of the Proposed Project, determines that the energy performance project is classified as a Type II Action pursuant to the SEQRA Regulations at Section 617.5(c))(1) [maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in the structure or facility] and/or (2) [replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site] and/or (10) [routine activities of educational institutions];

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Tuxedo Union Free School District determines that the Proposed Project is a Type II Action pursuant to §617.5(c)(1), (2) and/or (10) of the SEQRA Regulations, will not have any significant environmental impacts, and no further action is necessary.

ENERGY PERFORMANCE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Tuxedo Union Free School District ("Board") after soliciting requests for proposals from energy services companies for the implementation of Energy Conservation Measures at all district facilities on an Energy Performance Contract basis appointed the energy services company, Honeywell; and WHEREAS, the Board previously authorized Honeywell to conduct a Comprehensive Energy Audit ("CEA") of School District property to determine what energy conservation measures might be installed under an energy performance contract; and

WHEREAS, the results of the Honeywell CEA have been reviewed and evaluated by the School District's consultant engineer, Energia, and the School District Administration to determine which comprehensive energy efficient technologies can realistically reduce the District's energy consumption and generate cost savings to the District; and WHEREAS, based upon said review and evaluation of the CEA, Energia and the School District Administration have identified and recommend the scope of energy conservation measures to be installed in District Facilities pursuant to an Energy Performance Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to enter into an Energy Performance Contract for the installation of energy performance measures with Honeywell, subject to the legal review and approval of the Contract by the School Attorney;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby approves the scope and the installation of energy performance measures and energy conservation services in District Facilities subject to the recommendation of Energia and School District Administration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby authorizes the Board President to execute an Energy Performance Contract between the School District and Honeywell that incorporates the energy conservation services and installations that are identified in the Contract and all supporting documents, as recommended and approved by the School Attorney and Energia.

PROPOSITION - ENERGY PERFORMANCE CONTRACT

That in order for the Tuxedo Union Free School District, in the County of Orange, New York, to receive an additional ten

percent (10%) of enhanced aid from the State of New York, the voters of the District hereby authorize the Board of Education to undertake certain energy conservation improvements to be made at various District facilities pursuant to an Energy Performance Contract as defined in Article 9 of the State Energy Law, such Energy Performance Contract separately authorized by the Board, with the estimated cost which is not to exceed \$2,000,000 for such energy conservation improvements to be offset by the energy cost savings achieved over the duration of such Energy Performance Contract plus any other allowable cost savings for which such Energy Performance Contract may qualify, with no resulting cost to the District.

The aforesaid Proposition shall appear on the ballots for the voting machines in substantially the following abbreviated form:

Shall the energy performance contract approved by the Board of Education of the Tuxedo Union Free School District be approved by the District's voters so that the District can receive an additional 10% state aid on the energy performance improvements to the District's buildings and facilities.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this proposition in the remaining Legal Notices of Annual Meeting, Election and Vote in the designated newspapers;
