

## **Summer 2021**



We are pleased to bring summer programs to all of our schools.

Summer programming will focus on supporting learning recovery and acceleration, as well as ensuring our students are safe and having fun this summer! High schools will be offering credit recovery also.

We are especially pleased to offer this to our fully remote students as a way to transition back to the building.

Teachers will be calling home to invite your children to attend, and /or you are welcome to call the school to request information.

## Fall 2021

While we have not finished out the 2020-21 school year, we are already beginning to think about fall 2021. We do not have a ton of information but we want to share with you what we do know.

At this time, the Maine Department of Education (MDOE) has shared that the <u>6 Requirements for Schools</u> will continue to be in effect in the fall. This includes wearing masks and social distancing. This could change before fall.

We are working to hire staff and secure spaces for additional classrooms, using Elementary and Secondary School Education Relief funds, so that all students can return safely.

We are also looking into the option to pool test 30% of our students and staff for COVID -19, which may mean we do not have to put into effect the social distancing requirements. Because things are in flux right now, we are trying to plan as best we can.

We are working with a regional program to create a remote academy for 2021-22. There will be limited seats available. If you are thinking a fully remote-learning option works for your child, please complete this survey. This indicates interest and does not confirm a space in the remote academy.
