GRADUATION 2021

Metuchen High School Commencement Ceremony will be held on Tuesday, June 15th at 5:00pm. Graduation, tickets, and the logistics of graduation are discussed with seniors during rehearsals. On the last day of graduation rehearsal, students receive five graduation tickets. Graduating seniors do not need a ticket to gain entrance to the MHS Stadium.

The Ceremony is held in the football stadium (weather permitting). If it rains on the 15th, an alert will be sent out advising you that the ceremony has been moved to the raindate (June 16th). Notice of this will go out by the Metuchen High School Alert system by 2:00pm the day of graduation.

Senior parents are advised that all graduates who participate in the ceremony must be properly attired under their gowns (boys must wear pants, socks, shoes, and a shirt with a collar—shorts, sneakers, sandals, and t-shirts are not permitted).

ATTENTION SENIORS

Graduation Survey and Final Transcripts: The Graduation Survey must be completed before June 10th by ALL seniors, not only those planning to attend college -- it is a graduation requirement for all. Selection of Attending College will let us know where to send your final transcript.

Instructions here:

1. Complete the Graduation Survey in Naviance (About Me, Surveys, Surveys Not Started - unless you've started then you'd selected Surveys in Process). You must identify your post-graduation plans and name your attending college here as well.

The Graduation Survey is required of all seniors, not only those planning to attend college.

If you ARE planning to attend college in the fall:

2. Select your ATTENDING COLLEGE in Naviance (Colleges, Colleges I'm applying to, Select ATTENDING COLLEGE). This is how we'll know where to send your final transcript.

Transcript Fees

The first three transcripts sent for each senior during the application process are free and a fee of \$1.00 is charged for each additional transcript sent. Payment is due the day of Senior Sign-Out. We will send an email to all families the week before sign-out letting you know the amount due.

WHERE ARE YOU GOING? Please inform Guidance of all College Admissions Decisions, plans for career training or the military: Please inform us of your college acceptances. As you receive admissions decisions, you need to inform the Guidance & School Counseling Office whether you have been <u>accepted, wait-listed, deferred or denied</u> for each school. You may enter this information through your Naviance account under "Colleges I'm applying to" (https://.student.naviance.com/metuchen). Find the "Results" column of the list and click on the pencil icon.


PROJECT SENIORS '21


