


PBIS Referrals (examples from one OCESD school)

Average Referrals Per Day Per Month




Referrals by Time

All, Aug 1, 2020 - May 20, 2021




Referrals by Location

All, Aug 1, 2020 - May 20, 2021




Referrals by Day Of Week

All, Aug 1, 2020 - May 20, 2021




Referrals by Problem Behavior

All, Aug 1, 2020 - May 20, 2021




Referrals by Grade

All, Aug 1, 2020 - May 20, 2021




Referrals by Student

Notes From Meeting

Affinity Groups

Meeting began with Ruby Thomas reporting out how the Affinity Group presentation went. Ruby spoke to the parents about growing up in Oroville. The group discussed the presentation and identified two key points:

Looking at different ethnic groups through a different lens helps build understanding.

Students and teachers both need to be educated on different cultures. Keep personal beliefs to yourselves.

Affinity groups will resume next year and we will add more meetings. Our goal is to grow more participation and more affinity groups.

Discussed PBIS Article

Members of the group identified something from the article that resonated with them, then we discussed that idea or comment. Everyone in the group brought forward a key idea from the article to discuss. The group emphasized the need to communicate with the parents and students in tier 1 before it gets to level 2 and 3. It was noted a general trend of more kids needing tier 2 and 3 support. This supports the need for more training and diligence in an effective implementation.

New Board Policies

Policies were sent to all the committee members. Janet asked the group what they noticed regarding new policies. Members mentioned they liked the changes and thought it was very positive.

Janet reviewed AR 5144(a) Discipline. She pointed out the change in language. There was a discussion on how the PBIS aligns with the policy. Renee Henderson, Ishi Principal, gave some examples from Ishi on strategies they were trying such as:

- reverse suspension
- structured day
- alternative assignments such as “Rewriting your Story”

Members of the group also supported the positive encouragement, leadership opportunities and celebrating every small success is effective.

Year in Review

What worked well

Committee agreed that a smaller group of people (10-12) is a good size as long as the different groups are represented.

Group appreciates getting information in advance. The meeting discussions can be more meaningful.

Reminders for the meetings were helpful.

What can we improve

We need more diverse people attending.
