As a follow-up to yesterday's message, the administration and the Board of Education met today to discuss graduation, awards night, and quarantine guidelines related to covid-19. Outlined below is what has been determined to be our best course of action moving forward.


Awards Night:

The awards night will take place on June 2nd. As was done last year, staff, board members, and administration will be making personal deliveries throughout the evening. Seniors should have received notification of the expected time of delivery. If you have not received anything, please contact the school office on Tuesday, June 1st, 2021 so arrangements can be made.

Covid-19:

We reviewed the Iowa County Health Department Quarantine Guidelines and made the following determinations. A student who was identified as a **close contact** (excluding students with confirmed positives) would be eligible to be tested on day 6 or after his or her exposure to a positive case. If the test comes back as negative, he or she would be eligible to end the quarantine on day 7. You would need to bring a physical copy or email a copy of your negative test to colday@barneveld.k12.wi.us. If not tested, the 10th day would be the last day of quarantine if there are no symptoms - please see the visual below.
