WHEREAS, the Madison Board of Education ("Board") allows all non-aligned 12 month employees ("Employees") to carry over five (5) vacation days accrued during an academic year; and

WHEREAS, it is the Board's understanding that the onslaught of the COVID-19 pandemic has precluded Employees from utilizing many of their vacation days accrued during the 2020-2021 academic year to date; and

WHEREAS, the Board anticipates that Employees will simultaneously attempt to utilize vacation days accrued during the 2020-2021 academic year prior to expiration of same; and

WHEREAS, the Board needs to ensure sufficient staff coverage; and

WHEREAS, the Board wants to allow Employees adequate opportunity to use their vacation days accrued during the 2020-2021 academic year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby extends the expiration date of five (5) additional vacation days accrued by Employees during the 2020-2021 academic year, thus allowing Employees to carry over a total of ten (10) vacation days accrued during the 2020-2021 academic year until the completion of the 2021-2022 academic year. Employees will not be permitted to utilize vacation days earned during the 2020-2021 academic year beyond the completion of the 2021-2022 academic year without written approval from the Superintendent.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall not have any precedential effect upon the accrual and/or utilization of vacation days by Employees during any future school years.

- Between Owner and Contractor and A-201-General Conditions of the Contract for Construction, as prepared by the Board Attorney, within ten (10) days of the date hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board Attorney is hereby directed to draft the agreement with the successful bidder consistent with this Resolution and with the terms contained in the bid documents approved by the Board for the Project. The Board President and the Board Secretary are hereby authorized to execute such agreement and any other documents necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.
