GOOD NEWS:

1. Meijer Donation

Griff Mills, Superintendent of TSD, thanked Bill Deaton and the Meijer area stores for the donation of \$1,500.00 Meijer gift cards, the money will be used for those families in need.

2. DECA

Carly Lundgren, DECA Club Advisor at Taylor High School, shared great news regarding the DECA program.

- The DECA program had 20 students attend the Leadership Conference over the summer and 20 different students attended the State Leadership Conference in the fall.
- 35 DECA students competed at districts in December and won 60 medals. Of the 35 students 30 of them won at least one medal.
- State Competition is coming up and students tested February 22, 2021. 28 students are competing for states. The week of March 8th students will start their role play and on March 17th the district will find out what students will make it to the international competition.
- One TSD student broke the school record with her test score, Ellie Kwaske.
- An alumni that graduated two years ago took 1st place at states for the collegiate DECA, Vheena Vhillareal. She is competing for EMU.

Rhonda Danaj, Board President thanked Mayor Sollars and the City of Taylor for their donation of student masks to the district.

1. Covid-19 Update

Mary Ann Cyr, Asst. Superintendent of Covid and Communication presented a Covid-19 update, New CDC Guidance "Operational Strategy for K-12 Schools Through Phased Mitigation".

- Correct use of masks
- Physical distancing
- Physical distancing on the bus
- · Handwashing and respiratory etiquette
- Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities
- Contract tracing, isolation and quarantine
- 439 staff members are scheduled for their 2nd vaccination
- Reminder that asynchronous days for staff vaccines will be 2/25/21 & 2/26/21

D. Meyers and R. Danaj asked questions regarding students eating and drinking while wearing face masks and the protocol for cleaning the buses.

Ms. Cyr responded that the district has purchased face shields for students and are encouraging students to wear them. She also stated all buses will be cleaned and disinfected after every run.

2. Back to School Update

Griff Mills, SuperIntendent of TSD, shared a slideshow of today's orientation which included our Pre-K, 6th and 9th grade students and students new to TSD. He stated it is nice to see and hear the students express their excitement to return to school. He reminded everyone that this is what it is all about, we are here for the students.

3. Reconfirm Taylor School District Extended Covid-19 Learning Plan

Griff Mills, Superintendent of TSD, reminded everyone that nothing has changed from the plan. He did a quick review of what is required of TSD under this plan. He also reminded everyone of the schedule change this week due to the vaccination of staff.

Tuesday, February 23, 2021 - PreK-5 students beginning school

Wednesday, February 24, 2021 - Regular School Day

Thursday, February 25, 2021 - Asynchronous Day (Vaccination Day)

Friday, February 26, 2021 - Asynchronous Day (in case of side effects from vaccinations)

Monday, March 1, 2021 - 6-12 students beginning school

Cynthia Nickel, Asst. Superintendent for Curriculum, presented on the iready math and reading scores.

Tracy Carroll, School Improvement Coordinator, shared the NWEA math and language arts growth in addition to the middle and high school 1st semester grades. The information shared was from the testing window of January 25th - February 12 and the last testing window for the school year will be May 3rd - May 21st

PUBLIC COMMENT

Superintendent Mills noted that the district is addings questions being asked to our Q & A page on the TSD website.

- The number of subs that are taking the place of teachers that are deciding to take a leave of absence or retire because of their concerns about returning face to face.
- Why can't teachers choose to remain teaching virtually instead of face to face.
- Concerns with technology issues in our buildings. Buildings have slow or no internet connections.

1. Reconfirm Taylor School District Extended Covid-19 Learning Plan

Griff Mills, Superintendent TSD, stated that there is no adjustment to the plan. He did want to address the technology issue; of the people that he asked today there were no issues. He did state that he is aware the district does have some issues. He has reached out to the districts Interim Director of IT and it is something the district is working on. He recommended continuing to put in help tickets as problems arise

Vicky Horth and Jodi Thomas asked questions regarding what happened to the IT Director that was hired and is there a problem with students trying to log in using their own devices. There were also concerns if the use of personal devices would be a liability for the district.

Superintendent Mills responded that last Friday via email the new IT Director declined the position. He will check on the use of students using their own devices. He also stated that in his previous district personal devices were not to be used but would look into that as well.

2. TFT Negotiations

John Kava, Collins and Blaha Attorney stated that the TFT took the ratified agreement to their members last week with both the Board of Education and TFT approval, the contract will be effective beginning 2/22/21 through 6/30/22. He went over some of the openers for the negotiations of the contract.

- Eliminated the first 2 steps of the contract
- Rework wage scale which would start teachers at a higher starting salary
- Approximate 4% total increase at each step
- Other members of union are also receiving a wage increase
- Next year teachers will also receive their step and lane
- The district cost saving would be the dismissing of the two arbitrations off the books
- The 8 stages of the learning plan to get students back to school by March 1st

3. Cancellation of the Committee of the Whole Meetings

Griff Mills, Superintendent to TSD, stated in the 3 ½ months that he has been here the district has not had a Committee of the Whole meeting. He also stated that if a special meeting or a workshop is needed we can always add one.

Rhonda Danaj asked if committees can report at regular meetings. Superintendent Mills responded yes and added that the goal is to have two board meetings per month.

4. Soliant Addendum

Griff Mills, Superintendent to TSD, stated this is an addendum to our soliant contract to hire Special Education Para Pros.
