SCHEDULED REPORTS

1. Covid Update

Mary Ann Cyr, Asst. Superintendent for Covid and Communications, gave the following updates regarding Covid:

- 19 students and 63 staff members have recently tested positive.
- Of the covid cases/quarantines, none have been teachers.
- Only students or staff that have been in the building are on the dashboard but the district does keep a record of all cases.
- The district continues to connect with the Director of Health and Human Services for the Wayne County Health Department.
- The Superintendent also stays in contact with the surrounding district Superintendent with regards to what other districts are doing.
- Continue to get recommendations from the CDC.
- The district will continue to guarantine individuals for 14 days.
- There has been an uptick in numbers in our community and schools

2. Back to School Update

Griff Mills, Superintendent, stated that the reason the district shut down wasn't solely because of our numbers but the district doesn't have the staff to transport students and keep our students and staff safe.

Richard Klee, Taylor High School Principal, shared the following information regarding upcoming dates and events at Taylor High School.

- April 21st academic awards will be distributed via drive through for the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school year.
- May 5th Decision Day, Senior Career and College Decisions.
- May 20th Senior Day (food trucks, games, music and drive in movie). This will be in lieu of a senior prom.
- May 26th Senior Check Out (pay fines, return books/devices and distribute cap and gowns)
- June 2nd Senior Farewell Parade. Mr. Klee thanked the city for putting this together.
- June 3rd Graduation. This will be in groups through Taylor High School gym. There will also be a video of the full ceremony given to each senior.

Cynthia Nickel, Asst. Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction, gave an update on testing dates and EBT cards.

- The district is in collaboration with Wayne RESA and the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) looking at make up days for testing (PSAT, SAT & WorkKeys).
- Secondary principals are sending out schedules with rescheduled testing dates.
- Elementary (3-5) will be assessing students using the M-STEP test.
- Families have begun receiving their EBT cards.

Griff Mills, Superintendent, gave an update to the Board and the Community regarding a Bond Steering Committee that was put together in order for our district to move forward with a bond proposal. The committee consists of 24 people that represent the school and community.
