3.01 Superintendent's Report/Asst. Superintendent's Report

Supt. Williams:

- Processed and approved schools of choice applications last week and will continue to do so while there is still a vacancy for the Director of Pupil Accounting.
- In the process of scheduling an initial planning meeting with members of the Kennedy and Truman staff to identify and find chars for committees that we will need for our high school merger. In addition to the Curriculum Committee there will be Athletics, extra-curricular and community engagement committees. Board members are invited to be a part of the process on the planning level prior to voting to approve the committee recommendations in a formal manner.
- Update on property transfer to the City of Inkster: Waiting on the draft land transfer agreement to be sent back from Inkster. Once the language is finalized, the transfer agreement will be on the board agenda for the next board meeting.
- Completed sending the back to school information for the August edition of the Taylor Today magazine.

- Worked with Assist Supt and HR Director to review the 25 or more teacher applicants for the vacant teaching positions. Interviews will be scheduled soon.
- Worked with Dr. Rod Green in preparation for the Board retreat workshop scheduled for Wednesday, July 26, 2017. Rod will be helping the board with a review of roles and responsibilities, an introduction to the MASB board self-evaluation instrument, a review of the current mission and vision, and an introductory discussion about the strategic planning process.

Asst. Supt. Cyr:

- Model Schools Conference Update: The attendees met on July 18th to discuss next steps to create ad hoc committees to prepare and plan for the Wall to Wall Academies. The planning will include discussions regarding academy choices, curriculum integration, extra-curricular activities, and physical structure. The next step is to contact Clearwater HS and request a site visit. The next meeting will be held on August 14th.
- Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) New Dashboard: Based on new federal education law, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) will replace "No Child Left Behind". Michigan is changing its school accountability system and is moving away from an accountability model based solely on test scores and graduation rates. It is endorsing a Dashboard system comprised of six components: Proficiency, Growth, Graduation rate, English learner progress, School quality indicators, Participation in state assessments, Expulsion and suspensions for all students. The Dashboard will be rolled out in three phases with the first phase starting in late Fall of 2017.
- New Prospective TSD Staff We are preparing the teacher interviews at the elementary level for the 28 strong applications.
- HR is posting the coaching model job descriptions.
- Summer PD Summer Professional Development is in full swing at the TSD Board of Education. Since June 21st, 104 TSD teachers, administrators, and coaches have filled over 200 training slots in 12 sessions.
