The Bobby Joe Turney Memorial Scholarship Fund is open to anyone aspiring to attend a university, college, trade school, technical institute, vocational training or other post-secondary education program in the 2018-2019 academic years.

The Memorial Scholarship Fund will award one \$500.00 scholarship.

Applicants must submit a personal essay describing past or present community involvement, future goals, family values, and ways that The Bobby Joe Turney Scholarship will assist in attaining these goals.

In addition to a personal essay, applicants must submit two letters of recommendation that will address the candidate's personal and academic accomplishments.

Unlike most scholarship programs, the checks are written directly to you instead of your school, so winners may use the money not only toward tuition, but books, living expenses, etc.

This scholarship shall be awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, religion, age, marital status, sex, national origin, disability, veteran status, or any other factor unrelated to the scholarship criteria.
