**Dyslexia Program:**

During the 2020-2021 school year, Lee County School District utilized the evidenced-based Barton Reading & Spelling Program in one-to-one intervention or small groups of 1-3 students to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia. This intervention program is Orton-Gillingham based and is designed to provide instruction that best addresses the needs of students with dyslexia characteristics. The structured design of the curriculum follows the Science of Reading research, therefore, providing for the students' needs.

**Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention:**

During the 2020-2021 school year, fourteen (14) students attending Lee County School District received dyslexia intervention services from trained dyslexia interventionists.

**Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia:**

During the 2020-2021 school year, twenty-two (22) students attending Lee County School District have been identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.
