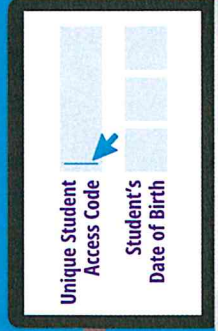

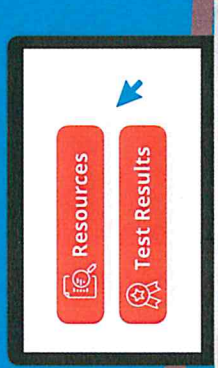
Find the **unique access code** on your child's paper STAAR report card.

Visit **TexasAssessment.gov** and enter the access code and date of birth.

Review your child's results and the personalized resources to support learning at home.

At the beginning of the school year, **discuss** the results with your child's teacher and work together to support your child's learning.

This year, STAAR results will not be used to evaluate teachers or grade schools. They are for learning only and are meant to show where your child is meeting grade level expectations in each subject and where they may need additional support.
