Extended School Year Services will be offered to K- 12 students with disabilities who meet eligibility.

- Monday - Friday, 8:30 - 12:00
- Fayetteville High School
- Lunch provided Monday-Friday
- Food will be sent home on Thursday of each week consisting of seven breakfasts and 2 lunches for the weekend

ESY will be staffed daily with one special education designee, 3 special education teachers, 8 paraprofessionals and 1 nurse. Speech Therapy Services will be provided 3 days weekly. Occupational Therapy and Physical Therapy will be provided two days weekly. Transportation will be provided for those who need it.
