

## Summer School Information

### 10:00am-12:00pm Session

#### Important Dates/Times

- Summer school will be held from **June 14-July 15** from 10:00am-12:00pm, **Monday-Thursday**
- There will be no summer school **Monday, July 5**
- Students can be dropped off for summer school starting at **9:45am** each morning
- Car riders will be released from summer school starting at **11:50am**

#### Arrival

- Bus riders
  - Drop off in the front circle drive on Reynolds Dr.
  - Bus students enter through the front doors (door 1)
- Car riders (Please refer to the map on the back)
  - Drop off in the upper **northwest** parking lot
  - Car riders enter through **door 6**
  - Parents/guardians please use **McComb St.** to **enter** and **exit** the parking lot at arrival to help avoid traffic from the 8-10 session.

#### Dismissal

- Bus riders
  - Exit through the front doors (door 1)
- Car riders (Please refer to the map on the back)
  - Pick up in the **northeast** parking lot, starting at 11:50am
    - Note, this is a different parking lot than you used at arrival
  - Students will exit through **door 7**
    - Note, this is a different door than they go in at arrival
  - Parents are asked to stay in their car – a staff member will help get your student loaded
  - Parents/Guardians will be given a car tag at drop off on the first day. Please write your students name on it and place it in the windshield each day at dismissal
  - Parents/guardians please use Reynolds Drive to enter and exit the parking lot at dismissal

#### Other Information

- Breakfast/Lunch – School staff reached out to each parent regarding whether they wanted their student to receive a breakfast and/or lunch.
  - For those who previously indicated, breakfast will be grab-and-go (granola bars, pop-tarts, etc)
  - For those who previously indicated, a frozen lunch will be sent home daily
- Students are required to wear masks during summer school
- Students are asked to bring their own reusable water bottles to school. Water bottle filling stations are available to students.
- Students will receive Math and Reading instruction daily

#### Illness/Absences

- If your child is experiencing any symptoms we ask that you keep them home from summer school. If students become ill or are exposed to students who become ill, we will be following the Illinois State Board of Education Guidance Document. We will be in consultation with our district health care professionals and seek guidance from our Country Health Department.
