West Band "Keys to Success"

You are joining a class like none other. Band is not only a class. It is a team and a family. Like any other team we will be working together, learning together, performing together, competing together, and traveling together. It is important that everyone has a sense of belonging and tries their hardest to give their best for the sake of the entire band. Along with this great opportunity comes added responsibility and expectations for excellence.

Expectations

- Come prepared every day with your instrument, necessary items (reeds, drum sticks, mouthpiece) and your <u>own</u> music. (West Band Folder & Method Book)
- Come to class early so you can get your instrument, music, and stand ready. Warm up your instrument <u>quietly</u> and wait for the director to start rehearsal.
- Absolutely No gum, food, or drink will be allowed in the band room.
- Handle instruments with extreme care and respect. Use of drum equipment, stereo, piano, and other students' instruments is prohibited.
- Absolutely no horse play will be allowed in any part of the band room.
- Attend sectional rehearsals

Student Responsibilities

- Be prepared to participate and work every day. Your instrument, a positive attitude, music, and a pencil are your tools. BRING THEM EVERY DAY.
- Caring for your instrument and music is your job. Instruments may be stored in the instrument room or designated area at the student's own risk. Your name should be clearly marked on the outside of your case. The instrument room will be monitored during the day and locked after school. However, the school will not be responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items.
- Music slots and music folders will be given to students. Sheet music will be provided for all students.
- It is your responsibility to learn your music. You will need to take your instrument and music
 home to practice until you have successfully learned your music. All students should take their
 instrument home at least two times each week and should be practicing an average of <u>90</u>
 minutes each week. Students may pick their instrument up at the end of the school day
 before they go home.
- Students will pay attention and NOT talk while the Band Director is speaking or working with other groups of students.
- Students will attend each concert and wear the proper band uniform for all concerts and performances.

Black dress pants, West Band Polo shirt, Black dress shoes/ socks

Note: jeans or tennis shoes will not be allowed

West Band Grading Policy

NO-Instrument Policy for Band (20% of grade)

Each time a student forgets his/her instrument he/she will receive a N.P. (No-Play) They will be given a penalty writing assignment to work on during the class period.

NO-Music Policy for Band (20% of grade)

Each time a student forgets or loses their music he/she will receive a N.M. Students should always write their name and band number on top of their music. If they lose their music they should check the lost - and – found music box and their music slot before asking for new copies of the music. A students' grade will also be lowered each time their music is found left out after class.

Playing TESTS (20% of grade)

Tests will be given during sectional time or during the band class. Students may retake a test one time to get a better grade. This can be done any day within the test week or on the make-up day. A schedule of all test dates will be provided to the student at the beginning of each semester.

Counting TESTS (20% of grade)

Counting tests will be given every other Monday. These tests can not be retaken. If a student is absent on a test day they may take the test on the scheduled make up day.

Practice Weekends (20% of grade)

Students must take their instrument home every weekend to practice.

CHAIR PLACEMENTS (no points)

Chair placements will be given occasionally to order a section. Each student will play the selection of music and the band director will determine the chair placement based on the students performance. Chair placements only determine where a student sits within the section, and do not affect his/her grade.

BAND CONCERTS and COMPETITIONS AFTER SCHOOL HOURS (50% of student's grade)

Concerts and Band Competitions are what we work toward in band class. It is very important that every student be present at these concerts. Students will be given at least one month notice of the time and location of the concert so that parents may arrange for the transportation of the student to and from the concert. We encourage parents to support their child by attending each concert. If people miss a band competition it could hurt the entire bands chance of getting a high rating.

FAILURE TO ATTEND THE SCHEDULED CONCERT or COMPETITION

It is impossible to make up a missed concert/competition. Should a parent have a reason to appeal the student's failure to attend a concert, this excuse will be provided to the band director in writing for review with the school principal. The review may result in one of the following: 1) the student may be excused from the concert and evaluated on their ability to play the concert music, or 2) the student will not be excused from the concert and will lose 50% of their grade for the marking period. It would help the process if the principal and band director were given written notice before the concert. Should the student be allowed to play the concert music for a grade, they will do so by making a cassette tape recording of the music on their own time at home, and then submit the tape to the band director before the end of the marking period. Failure to do so will result in the letter grade of E. A student may be asked not to attend a concert by the Principal or the Band Director because of improper conduct or lack of effort. Students must be in proper band uniform for all performance.
