#### TO ALL PARENTS OF STUDENTS IN GRADES 7-12:

It's that time of year again when we are making the big push towards preparing for final exams. The last day of in person instruction for high school students is Tuesday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. Wednesday, June 16<sup>th</sup> will be a remote learning/virtual day for high school students. Students taking Regents exams are expected to log on and complete work assigned by teachers on Microsoft Teams. This will allow our BOCES CTE students to attend their CTE student recognition ceremonies at the Wildwood Campus which are being staggered throughout the day June 16<sup>th</sup>. Beginning Thursday, June 17<sup>th</sup>, students in grades 7-12 will attend school only on the days and times they are scheduled for a Regents or final exam. (Refer to back side for Regents schedule). **\*\*If you/your child are uncertain which exam(s) your child is taking, please contact our guidance office.\*\***

Reminder – Canisteo-Greenwood CSD will be closed on Friday, June 18<sup>th</sup> and Monday, June 21<sup>st</sup> for unused snow days. Regular morning bus runs will be in effect mornings on Thursday, June 17<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> through Thursday, June 24<sup>th</sup>. Students with morning exams needing a ride home after morning testing Thursday, June 17<sup>th</sup> or on Tuesday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> will need to arrange for their own mid-day transportation home or they may wait on campus (in assigned location) for their regularly scheduled p.m. bus run as the elementary school will be in session full days. Students will be allowed to leave school after their exams, provided they arrive back on campus in time for their p.m. bus run home. Wednesday, June 23<sup>rd</sup> & Thursday, June 24<sup>th</sup> bus runs will be mid-day due to early dismissal of the elementary school. Grab and go/limited lunch menu will be available in the HS cafeteria from 11:00 -11:30 during Regents testing.

Due to the pandemic, and current restrictions and guidelines for social distancing, we are planning to hold our academic awards ceremony (grades 7-12) and our senior awards ceremony virtually, as we did in 2020. Students receiving awards will receive a notification letter in the mail prior to the virtual ceremony. The awards and recipients will be announced during the virtual ceremony. The video of the ceremony will be published virtually for award recipients and families, and awards will be distributed to the recipients subsequent to this publication.

Seniors are scheduled to receive their caps/gowns on Friday, June 11<sup>th</sup> in our drive through event in the elementary loop. Seniors will participate in the Senior Walk on Monday, June 14<sup>th</sup> and need to come prepared with cap/gown.

Graduation will be held on Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, at 7:00 p.m. at the athletic field behind the Elementary School in Canisteo. Seniors need to arrive at the Elementary School Gym promptly at 6:20pm with cap and gown. Due to social distancing requirements and Dept. of Health guidance, seniors will be limited to four tickets for attendees. Un-ticketed entry will not be permitted. In case of rain, the ceremony will be postponed to a later date and notification will be sent through the automated calling system.

Report cards for students in grades 7-11 will be mailed home on June 30<sup>th</sup> or shortly thereafter by the High School Guidance Office. Seniors report cards will be distributed at graduation on Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, provided all obligations are satisfied. Your student's counselor will reach out if summer school or credit recovery is needed as a result of a failing course.

Finally, you can help us insure the success of your child on final exams by helping him/her study and by seeing to it that he/she is properly rested prior to taking exams. If you have any questions, please make an appointment to meet and/or speak with the individual classroom teachers involved.
